**The NAWIC InfluenceHER Awards recognize the top women in construction and/or construction related industries in the Central Florida area. The awards will be given during NAWIC's 57<sup>th</sup> Annual Awards Banquet on September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019, in Orlando.**

**Eligibility Requirements**

Honorees will be recognized in the following categories: Tradeswoman, C-Level, and Business Owner of the Year. Nominations are to be made specific to each category and NAWIC members are not eligible. Finalists are to attend the award ceremony and agree to be interviewed and photographed. The nominees must fit the descriptions below and hold the appropriate role for the category.

**Tradeswoman of the Year**

Open to women working in the construction related trades. Tradeswomen work in fields such as, but not limited to: Carpenters, Electricians, Drywall Hangers, Welders, Plumbers, Insulations, Installers, Riggers, Masons, etc.

**C-Level Woman of the Year**

Open to women in C-level positions working in a construction related industry. The term C-level position refers to the highest-ranking executives in a company, with titles that usually begin with "chief." The three most common C-level positions include the chief executive officer, chief financial officer, and chief operating officer.

**Business Owner Woman of the Year**

Open to women business owners in a construction related industry. This award is a celebration of the accomplishments of successful businesswomen.
